# PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

Precautions to Be Taken in Handling and Storage: Do not transfer to unmarked containers. Store in closed containers away form heat. Avoid uncontrolled releases.

Other Precautions for Safe Use: Clean up material with soap and water. Do not allow product to dry completely. Do not inhale dust from dried-up product.

Procedures to Be Followed in the Event of a spill: Clean-up personnel need protection against skin and eye contact hazards. Contain spilled material and transfer to secure containers.
